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Ireland's Regulation of Artificial Intelligence Bill 2026



This bill establishes a national AI authority in Ireland, named Oifig IS na hÉireann, to domestically implement and enforce the EU AI Act (Regulation (EU) 2024/1689). It also amends several existing Irish laws, including those governing central banking, communications, consumer protection, and freedom of information, to align them with the EU's harmonized rules on artificial intelligence.

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Das v. Meta, Google, OpenAI & X

Plaintiff Kalishwar Das alleges that the defendants' AI systems unlawfully ingested, reproduced, and commercially exploited his copyrighted works, "The General Theory of Entirety" and "The Tangible Theorem of Divinity," for training purposes without authorization.



Jamendo v. Nvidia

Jamendo alleges that Nvidia used the MTG-Jamendo dataset, containing over 55,000 audio tracks, without permission to train its AI audio models, Fugatto and Audio Flamingo. The lawsuit seeks damages and an injunction to stop the alleged infringement..

Shakespeare v. Anthropic

Over 100 authors who opted out of a prior class action settlement filed a new copyright infringement suit against Anthropic and its executives. They allege the defendants used BitTorrent to unlawfully download, distribute, and retain their copyrighted books from pirate libraries like Library Genesis and Books3. The complaint asserts that Anthropic used these stolen works to build a permanent, general-purpose internal library for AI model training and other uses.

Bipartisan Kids Safety Deal in Congress

A bipartisan agreement from the House Energy and Commerce Committee, the Kids Internet and Digital Safety (KIDS) Act consolidates over a dozen bills to enhance online protections for minors. It empowers parents, establishes safety-by-default settings, strengthens privacy rules for children and teens, increases transparency from data brokers, and holds technology companies accountable.

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
